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Hubungan Edukasi Perawat Dengan Angka Kejadian Pasien Jatuh di Rumah Sakit
Mitra Plumbon Cirebon

ABSTRAK

Insiden keselamatan pasien adalah setiap kejadian yang tidak disengaja dan kondisi yang berpotensi mengakibatkan cedera yang dapat dicegah pada pasien. Jatuh memiliki banyak penyebab yang kompleks dan luas, seperti kelemahan otot, keseimbangan yang buruk, gangguan penglihatan, penggunaan obat-obatan tertentu, polifarmasi, bahaya lingkungan dan beberapa kondisi medis tertentu. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengetahui hubungan edukasi perawat dengan angka kejadian pasien jatuh di Rumah Sakit Mitra Plumbon Cirebon.

Jenis penelitian menggunakan penelitian kuantitatif dengan desain penelitian deskriptif korelasional dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah perawat di Rumah Sakit Mitra Plumbon Cirebon dan teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan metode *purposive sampling* sebanyak 84 orang. Pengambilan data menggunakan lembar kuesioner dan SPO pengkajian resiko jatuh. Analisa data dilakukan dengan menggunakan analisa univariat dengan persentase dan analisa bivariat dengan uji *chi square* (χ^2).

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa sebagian besar responden (78,6%) memiliki edukasi perawat yang baik dan sebagian besar responden (40,5%) tidak beresiko jatuh. Hasil uji statistik *chi square* (χ^2) diperoleh $p\ value = 0,000 < \alpha (0,05)$ menunjukkan bahwa H_a diterima artinya terdapat hubungan edukasi perawat dengan angka kejadian pasien jatuh di Rumah Sakit Mitra Plumbon Cirebon.

Diharapkan perawat dapat meningkatkan kemampuannya dalam penerapan patient safety untuk mencegah pasien jatuh dengan mengikuti seminar maupun pelatihan.

ABSTRACT

A patient safety incident is any unintentional occurrence and condition that has the potential to result in preventable injury to a patient. Falls have many complex and wide-ranging causes, such as muscle weakness, poor balance, visual disturbances, use of certain medications, polypharmacy, environmental hazards and certain medical conditions. The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between nurse education and the incidence of patient falls at Mitra Plumbon Cirebon Hospital.

This type of research uses quantitative research with a descriptive correlational research design with a cross sectional approach. The population in this study were nurses at Mitra Plumbon Cirebon Hospital and the sampling technique used a purposive sampling method of 84 people. Retrieval of data using questionnaires and SPO fall risk assessment. Data analysis was performed using univariate analysis with percentages and bivariate analysis with the chi square test (χ^2).

The results showed that most of the respondents (78.6%) had good nurse education and most of the respondents (40.5%) were not at risk of falling. The results of the chi square statistical test (χ^2) obtained p value = 0.000 < α (0.05) indicating that H_a is accepted, meaning that there is a relationship between nurse education and the incidence of falling patients at Mitra Plumbon Cirebon Hospital.

It is expected that nurses can improve their ability to apply patient safety to prevent patients from falling by attending seminars or training.
